PROXY VOTES AT DISTRICT MEETINGS

(Approved by Conference 11-4-2005 proposed as #1029)

While proxy voting will not be allowed, the District Commander may accept proxy "REPORTS" as necessary from absent members of the council- but those presenting the "Proxy" reports will not be allowed to vote.

In the absence of a squadron commander at district meetings, the squadron executive officer or administrative officer may act for the commander and in the absence of an officer for whom there is an elected assistant, the assistant may act for the principal. However, these are not really proxy arrangements but rather an assumption of command.

A Squadron Commander can designate an alternate squadron member or the District commander to vote for him at a USPS Governing Board Meeting. The National bylaws do not provide for proxy voting except in this case.
