USPS ANNUAL MEETING - SQUADRON DELEGATES

(was #1020) Approved at Spring Conference April 2, 2005

Refer to Section 10 of the USPS bylaws if any conditions change. The district shall not change any of these conditions.

Each squadron may be represented at the annual meeting and special meetings of the USPS by *delegates* appointed by that squadron provided that the squadron commander has certified the names of squadon delegates to such meetings.

Each squadron shall be allowed one delegate for every 100 active members or fraction thereof as of 75 days before the meeting.

No alternates may be authorized for such squadron delegates and no member of the Governing Boad may be a delegate.

With the call to the such meeting, the national secretary shall provide to each squadron appropriate forms for certifying each squadron delegate.

Each squadron commander shall provide a copy of such certification to each delegate who, at the applicable meeting, shall exchange it for voting credentials.

The vote of the squadron commander unable to attend an annual or special meeting of USPS or the Governing Board may be cast by an alternate who shall be either (1) any other member of the squadron or (2) the commander of the district to which the squadron is assigned. Such votes shall be cast under the authority and conditions granted to the squadron commander.

If a district commander is absent from an annual or special meeting of USPS or meeting of the Governing Board, the executive officer of that district may vote in the commander's stead and if neither is present, the administrative officer of that district may vote in the commander's stead.

VOTING AT ANNUAL OR SPECIAL MEETINGS OF USPS SHALL BE BY DELEGATES AND MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD ONLY.
