





3 crushed garlic cloves


1 teaspoon of Worcestershire sauce

Cambios propuestos a reglamentos de nacional, governing board sept 2021/proposed changes to bylaws at governing board's meeting

Topic 1, Election of Squadron and District Educational Officer

Existing Bylaw

Section 4.6 District and squadron educational officers and assistant educational officers shall be elected by the respective unit in the same manner as other district and squadron officers provided, however, no member may be nominated for such office unless, prior to nomination, the candidates qualifications have been approved by the national educational officer or as in 4.6.2 herein. Nomination and election of any person without such prior approval shall be voidable.

The Board of Directors has requested the following change

Section 4.6 District and Squadron Educational Officers shall be elected by their respective units in the same manner as the district and squadrons officers

Rationale

It should be left to the individual squadrons- club to decide who should be the educational officer and not the national organization. This bylaw can be considered as a policy but not as a mandatory bylaw. This would also eliminate unnecessary paperwork to be completed by the squadrons.

Topic IV, Qualification of Bridge Officers

Existing Bylaw

Section 7.9 All nominees for the offices of squadron commanders, executive officer, educational officer, administrative officer, secretary and treasurer shall have earned at least one advanced grade in been awarded at least one merit mark provided, however, that prior to the nomination of candidates for such offices, the District Commander may grant exception to the forgoing for good cause and shall report in writing, to the district council and to the National Executive Officer any exception granted with the reasons therefore.

The Board of Directors has requested the following change

Section 7.9 Reserved

Rationale

By eliminating this bylaw, squadrons/clubs would determine who should be in a leadership position. Squadrons may continue to set standards for office holders in the squadrons bylaw

Topic VI, District Secretary-Treasurer

The Committee on Rules recommends adding a new section 6.2.2

Section 6.2.2 The offices of secretary and treasurer may be held by the same person

Rationale

Bylaw section 7.3.2 allows squadrons to elect a secretary-treasurer. The change would allow district the same exemption. District bylaw might require amendment to take advantage of the exemption.



SABIAS QUE - DID YOU KNOW THAT

¡El Ponce Sail and Power Squadron celebra su 60 Aniversario! Este escuadrón fue formado en 1959 en el Club de Yates y Pesca de Ponce por un grupo de navegantes locales, que incluía a A.R. Busquets, E. Cámara, E. Ramos Casellas, F. Delgado, M.A. Tulla, M. Landesberg y otros. El escuadrón fue admitido oficialmente en los Escuadrones de Poder de los Estados Unidos y recibió su Carta el 14 de enero de 1961. Este fue el primer capítulo de USPS en el Caribe, y fue seguido de San Juan en 1962, Santa Cruz en 1973, Humacao en 1988, Arecibo en 1989, Santo Tomás en 1990, Boquerón en 1994 y Carolina en 1998. Hoy formamos el Distrito 33 de los Escuadrones de Poder de los Estados Unidos, ahora conocido como el Club de Navegación de Los Estados Unidos. Fuimos los pioneros de los cursos formales de navegación y seguridad en el agua, antes de que se aprobaran leyes al respecto en Puerto Rico.

The Ponce Sail and Power Squadron celebrates its 60th Anniversary! This squadron was formed in 1959 at the Ponce Yacht and Fishing Club by a group of local boaters, which included A.R. Busquets, E. Cámara, E. Ramos Casellas, F. Delgado, M.A. Tulla, M. Landesberg, and others. The squadron was officially admitted in the United States Power Squadrons and received its Charter on January 14, 1961. This was the first chapter of USPS in the Caribbean, and was followed by San Juan in 1962, St. Croix in 1973, Humacao in 1988, Arecibo in 1989, St. Thomas in 1990, Boquerón in 1994 and Carolina in 1998. Today we form District 33 of the US Power Squadrons, now known as America's Boating Club. We were the pioneers of formal boating and water safety courses, before any laws in that respect were approved in Puerto Rico.


