RECIPE FOR THE MONTH: Pineapple Cake

2 cups sugar
2 cups flour
2 eggs
2 tsp. baking soda
1 can crushed pineapple (20oz. Size) (Do not drain)
1 tsp. Vanilla
½ to ¾ cup chopped nuts (optional)
Mix above ingredients well. Bake 350 oven for 40 mins +/- in greased and floured 13X9 pan. Allow cake to cool a bit before icing.

Icing: 1-8 oz. Softened cream cheese, ½ stick butter, 1 ¾ cup powdered sugar and ½ cup chopped nuts (optional)
