Tender chicken breast breaded and topped with marinara sauce, baked provolone cheese with our house- made fettuccini marinara.

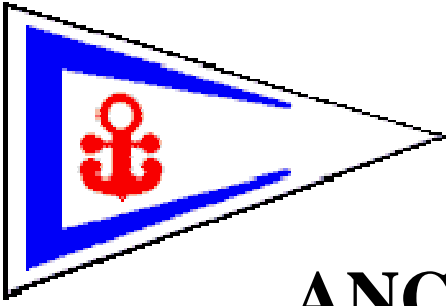
