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## **Fall Conference**

**US Coast Guard Commander Jonathan D. Theel,** presented a power point presentation on Long Island Sound Sector Search and Rescue. He stressed the importance when calling in a May Day to have: a call back number as well as a secondary

number, a location, the total number of persons on board, the nature of the distress (situation), a description of the vessel and to make sure all persons put on life jackets. This information determines how USCG quantifies the level of DISTRESS.

In 2014 there were 515 S & R cases; 130 lives were saved; 529 lives assisted; \$1.92 million in property was saved. Response was less than 30 minutes 95.51%. He gave many examples of calls that came in and how some of them were tracked down and rescued. With a capsize the most important factor is to STAY WITH THE BOAT.

## From the Merritt Parkway from both directions

Take Exit 54. Take connector to Route 1 South. Turn RIGHT. Turn LEFT at next light onto High Street (at 7-11 Store). Continue on High Street thru 2 stop signs. Turn RIGHT at the next stop sign (Cody-White Funeral Home). Travel to the end of the Green, turn LEFT, continue to stop sign. Turn LEFT on South Broadway. Take the next RIGHT onto Lafayette Street (Gulf Gas Station on corner).

Lafayette becomes Rogers Avenue. Pass Port Milford & U.S. Fisheries on the left. Milford Yacht Club entrance is the LEFT.

## From I-95

Exit 36 Plains Road, turn LEFT off exit. Follow signs for "Milford Hospital Emergency Room." This takes you across Route 1. Continue straight over the railroad bridge to a light across from Carvel. Turn LEFT toward the Hospital. Take the 3rd RIGHT onto Lafayette Street (Gulf Gas Station on corner). Continue with **Lafayette** above.
