Looking at the print version? You can find this link on the D-1 website (see footer). Click on Menu for Sounds of 1.

When the Zoom screen comes up if you already have Zoom installed on your machine click on the option in blue: Launch Meeting. Otherwise, click on the option: Download and Run Zoom.

- If you get a screen that has an option to Join a Meeting, click on that option.
- If the Host has not signed in, you will get a screen that says "Please wait for the host to start this meeting". Otherwise, you should see the host.
- At the end of the meeting, you can click on the option Leave near the bottom right of the screen. You will then get a larger button that says Leave Meeting. Click it and you can then close down the Zoom internet connection.

Note: if you are only getting a paper copy, you can go to the District website (see link at bottom of each page) and bring up the current Sounds of 1. You will be able to click the link from

there to join the Zoom meeting. You can also look at/print the Minutes of the 16 November, 2019 meeting and the Officer Reports for this meeting.



Not Getting e-mails from us?

At least 125 District 1 members have not given National (and therefore us) their emails and are getting the *Sounds of 1 (SO1)* via paper copy. The problem is that as plans change in these 'Covid' times, we are less able to let these members know of any changes in plans.

If you would like to add your email to the National system, please feel free to send an email to the editor (see above) allowing us to add you to the National list. We can report that we only get 1-2 emails per month from National so it is not a big burden. This method also gets you emails from your own Squadron as well as District.

If, however, you would like to get District emails but not those from National, we have a special list we can put you on that will give you only emails from District, including the link to the electronic copy of the SO1.

In either case, if you still want the paper copy of the SO1, ask us to continue that copy.

Getting Reports in the Age of Zoom

Reports that are normally handed out at a District Conference cannot be handed out when we meet on Zoom. Instead the Officer Reports and District Rosters will be emailed to those with email addresses in DB 2000. This email will be approximately one week before the conference.

Click on the Menu item for *Sounds of 1* and then click on the button for *Link to Sounds of 1*.
