


The boating community uses many acronyms that someone new to boating may not understand. Aids to navigation or ATONS is an excellent example. To help you and your students, America's Boating Channel has two videos on this important safety topic available to view and download for free at bit.ly/USPSABC.

<u>"Introducing ATONS</u>" shows how buoys, day beacons, and other marks provide aids to navigation, while <u>"Digital Charts and Virtual ATONS</u>" covers the effort underway to replace paper nautical charts with electronic navigation charts, including tips for using these enhancements and how they will make recreational boating safer.

Grant-funded through the U.S. Coast Guard, these videos also are available on <u>YouTube</u> and via the America's Boating Channel on-demand app on Roku or

Library of Boating Safety Videos

The boating community uses many acronyms that someone new to boating may not understand. Do students enrolled in our basic safe boating course understand that the acronym ATONS references aids to navigation? In 2020 America's Boating Channel produced "Introducing ATONS," a video showing how buoys, day beacons, and other marks provide aids to navigation. This short video offers a wonderful introduction to ATONS. In it, viewers also learn about categories such as lateral and regulatory ATONS, as well as special purpose and danger marks.



In 2022, another ATONS video was released. Entitled "<u>Digital Charts and Virtual ATONS</u>," it covers the effort underway to replace paper nautical charts with electronic navigation charts. This video introduces viewers to three types of new virtual aids to navigation. Also featured are tips for using these enhancements and how they will make recreational boating safer.

Remember, if you need a refresher before getting out on the water, you can access an invaluable library of videos produced by America's Boating Channel. The videos referenced here, and others, are available to USPS

members to view and download for free at <u>bit.ly/USPSABC</u>. There is an index to help you find the topic you need, which is very convenient for instructors who want to use these videos in the classroom without the need for an internet connection.
