

## Dual Bays Cruise 2017

### Cuttyhunk

No Discharge in either harbor. Best approach is from Buzzards Bay, not Canapitsit Channel unless at slack tide.

### Ferry

Passenger-only, M-Thurs daily, 2x/day Fri-weekend.

### Inner Harbor — 41°25.546'N, 070°55.497'W

Anchorage: A few spots may be found outside mooring field in >5'. Holding ground mud/eel grass.

Navigation: Entering Cuttyhunk Pond, stay in channel, 6.5' draft, don't turn starboard too soon to mooring field. Shallow outside mooring field. Be wary of picking up small craft moorings in shallow depth.

Amenities: Dinghy dock south of Town Marina.

Moorings: 50 available. No reservations/first come, \$45/night. Can accommodate up to 50' LOA, rafting allowed, 3 boats maximum. Often full on weekends by 1600. Pick up mooring and boat will come to you in the afternoon for fee.

Pilings: Generally reserved for larger boats. \$35–35/night. Call for reservations.

Slips: Fixed docks with pilings, \$1.50-\$2.50/ft. Shore power, 30 amp \$20/night, 50 amp \$30/night. Reserve via Dockwa.

Dockage: Temporary tie up, \$25/up to 4 hours. [2016]

Navigation: Stay in channel, draft at dock 10'.

Amenities: Several restaurants/ice cream/breakfast at Cuttyhunk Fishing Club.

Groceries/ice/WiFi. No showers or laundry. Lodging, Avalon Inn [website down] and Cuttyhunk Fishing Club. Trash \$5/bag. Dinghy dock on south side of town dock. Pump out 2x/week, schedule at

Outer Harbor — 41°25.714'N, 070°54.946'W

Anchorage: Holding ground rocky/mud/eel grass. No protection from N and NE winds.

Navigation: Avoid Pease Ledge and main channel.

Frog Pond Marine, 508-992-7530, monitors VHF 72

Moorings: 12 available. No reservations/first come, price not available.

Navigation: Moorings located south of Cuttyhunk Pond entrance.

Jenkins Moorings, 508-992-9294, monitors VHF 09

Moorings: 27 available. No reservations/first come, price not available.

Navigation: Moorings located north of Cuttyhunk Pond entrance.

Gosnold Fuel Service — 41°25.451'N, 070°55.406'W

Monitors VHF 72

Navigation: to port of channel, just inside Pond, near old Coast Guard station.

Fuel: Gas, diesel.
