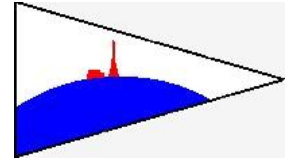

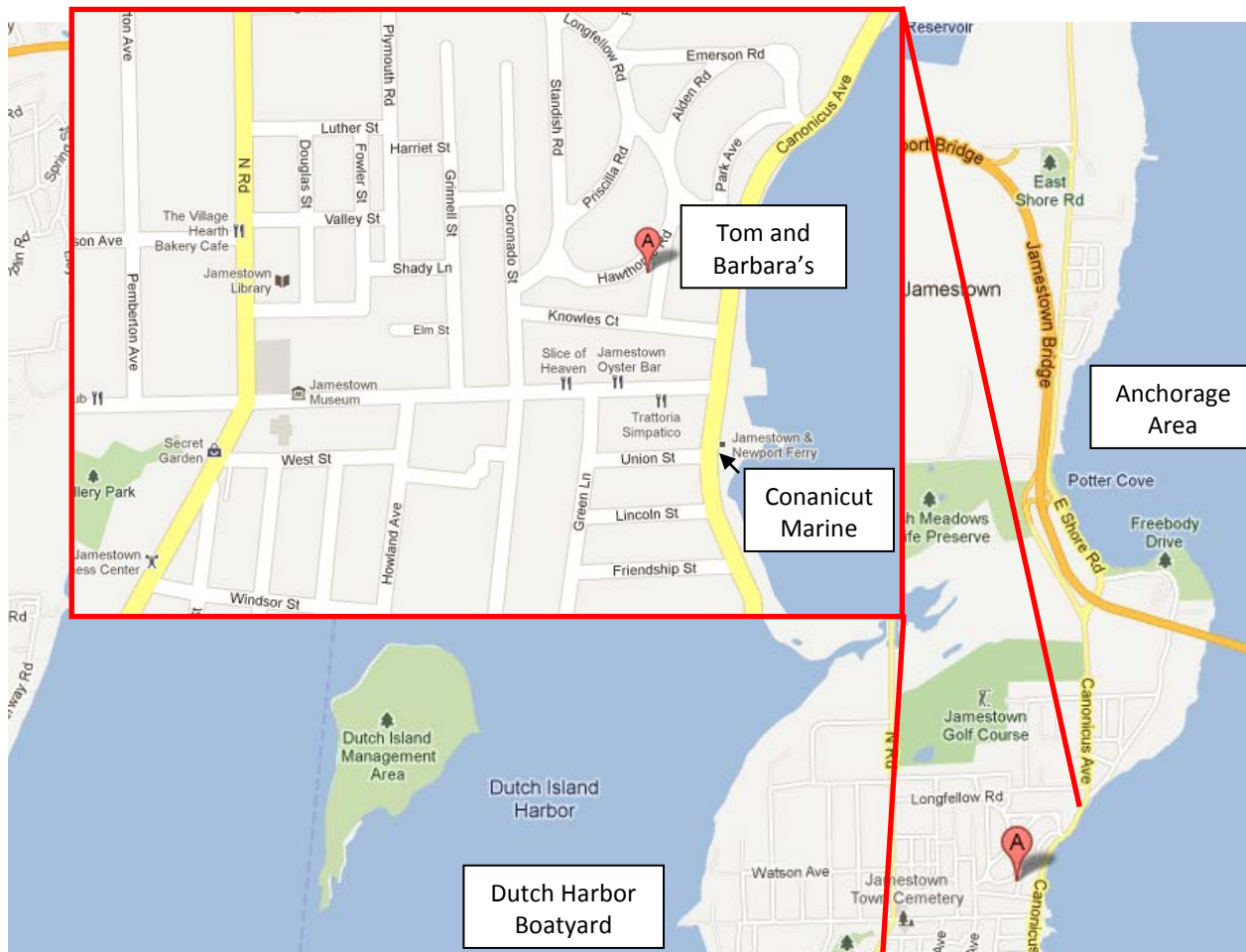
Welcome to Jamestown, RI!

*Address: **23 Hawthorne Rd, Jamestown** – very short walk from Conanicut Marine launch drop off. Head north (toward the Newport Bridge) along the Shore Road and turn at your second right (Knowles Court). Then turn left at the next block. We are on your right (shingled house with aqua trim).*



There are several options for Marinas – Conanicut Marine (very close with moorings and slips), and Dutch Harbor Boatyard (0.9 mile easy walk with moorings) plus an option for anchoring in Jamestown’s Potter Cove. Jamestown Boat Yard also has moorings but they are a longer walk to town.

Date members need to make their reservations with the Marina!_As soon as possible!
