Seminar overview: GPS has become a common tool for navigation. However using a GPS on the water is distinctly different from using a moving map display in your auto. This seminar explains the principles of waypoint navigation which you will use. It then shows you how to relate the GPS to your charts which provide essential information about your surroundings.
