## DIRECTIONS TO OUR ANNUAL POT LUCK SUPPER---MARINE AUCTION----WINE RAFFLE ON THURSDAY, JUNE 11<sup>TH</sup>

From Middletown and west of the river: Go south on Route 9 to I-95. Cross the Baldwin Bridge into Old Lyme heading toward New London. Take the first exit after the bridge into Old Lyme. Go left at the end of the ramp on Route 156 for about 4 miles. Just after Tiffany Farms and the Lyme Firehouse you'll go over a small bridge. Take an immediate left after the bridge. The Hamburg Cove Yacht Club will be right in front of you.

Alternatively: From east of the river go south on Route 151 in Cobalt to Sunrise Resort. Take a left towards Moodus then a right on Town Street (continuing on Route 151) to the junction with Route 82 (at Nino's Bistro). Continue to follow Route 82 south to Hadlyme Center (red light). Go left continuing on Route 82 to the junction of Route 156 (across from Fox Hopyard Golf Course). Turn right on 156 to Hamburg. Bear right on Cove Road just after Reynolds Auto. Hamburg Cove Yacht Club is on the right.

We'll start cooking hot dogs and hamburgers around 6:30. Don't forget to bring a dish to share, a bottle of your favorite wine to donate to the raffle and a nautical item to action off. The Squadron will provide hot dogs, hamburgers, wine and soft drink set-ups. If your inclination is for adult beverages, BYOB.
