

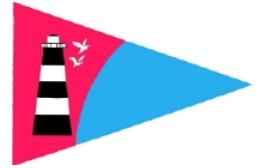

The education opportunities in 2022 are starting in January with the following:

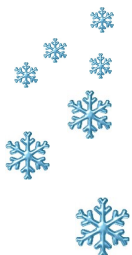
- Instructor Re-certification January 7th
