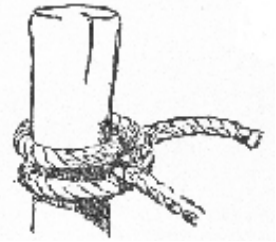


## *Spring Meetings:*
