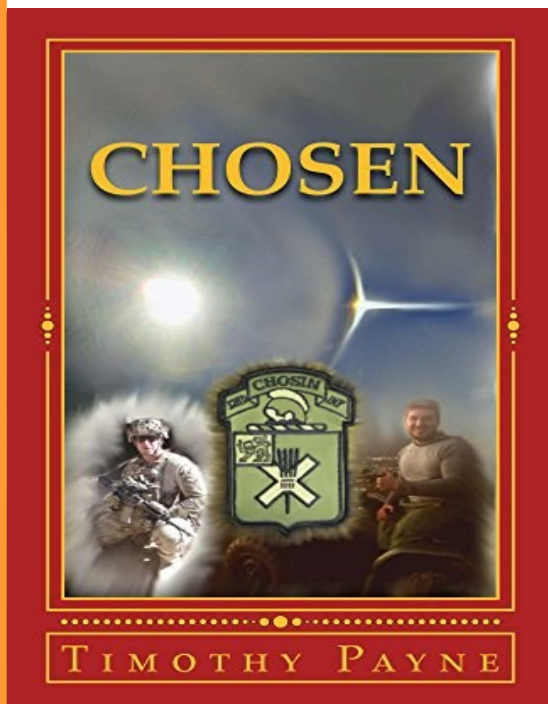

Staff Sergeant (SSG) retired Timothy Payne joined the United States Army to guard America after the attacks on September 11, 2001. The goal was to fight with SOF (Special Operation Forces) to destroy Americas' enemies; going to the root of the evil and cut off the head of the snake. The goal was met with severe opposition ranging from training injuries and assignment changes. After 4 SOF attempts, 11 years and 3 deployments, SSG Payne was severely injured when his Squad was under attack by Taliban forces in Southern Afghanistan. The attack resulted in the traumatic amputations of both his legs and severe damage to his dominant arm and hand.
