Some squadrons have put together "Early First Responder Teams" that monitor radio and respond to alerts. Then go out and help the distressed vessel. I asked about this treading on the USCGAUX, but they said the CG and the AUX were glad to have them available.

I spent most of my time in the education meetings this year, trying to see what was going to define us for the next year or two going forward. Like us, they are very concerned about membership and how it interacts with the ABC class and follow up classes. There was a lot of discussion on "Online" courses and how to capture people taking them into the squadrons. George will update us at the next meeting.

I wanted to share what I was doing with you, to show you that the squadrons are active and National is really working on all our problems. We will survive and thrive.






