Tips on How to Buy a New Boat

- 1. Want a new boat. Do not buy a boat without first having a survey of its worthiness from a reputable marina. Some insurance underwriters will not insure a boat with a survey older than six months.
- 2. If possible attend the survey and ask questions. Most Marinas are happy to discuss what may need repair.
- 3. Do not let price alone dictate who you have to do the survey. The reputation of the marina is just as important.
- 4. Treat the survey as a guide and not a pass or fail situation. Your may be interested in a "fixer upper". The survey will tell you just what is

wrong and what it will cost to repair. Remember insurance company will list what they will and will not cover.

- 5. Beware that even brand-new boats may have some adjustments needed. However these should be covered by the warranty.
- 6. You survey should include a current fair market value of the boat. This can be used as a negotiating point and is helpful in assessing the true value of the boat for insurance purposes.
- 7. A good survey will be a good investment for budget planning.

Winterized your Boat Yet? Here are Some Tips

1. Take off tiller/steering wheel. Cover/shrinkwrap boat

- 2. Lock cabin and leave spare key with marina manager
- 3. Pump out holding tank and add antifreeze to head
- 4. Drain water heater and bypass it
- 5. Drain freshwater system and run antifreeze through it
- 6. Run antifreeze through refrigeration, deck wash down pump, etc., per owner's manual
- 7. Drain shower sump and other places where water pools

- 8. Remove food
- 9. Open lockers to air
- 10. Take home cushions or store on their sides
- 11. Take home portable electronics
- 12. Close propane valves and take home portable canisters
- 13. Verify bilge pump and switch operate properly
- 14. Clean and dry bilges
- 15. Secure all ports and hatches
- 16. Turn off all circuit breakers
- 17. All seacocks should be closed except for cockpit drains
- 18. Plug exhaust ports
- 19. Check docklines and chafe guards center boat in slip
- 20. Add or adjust fenders for proper placement
