Chapter 7, page 69: Replace the existing paragraph 18 with the following: “Alcohol

Alcoholic beverages should be available and served only when the boat is completely anchored or docked. All crew members must be ready to serve the boat at any time during a cruise. An incapacitated crew member is one less crew to help. Limiting the alcohol may be necessary if your cruising schedule means early departures and long days on a waterway. The cruise plan should determine when the liquor locker is open.”

Page 214 paragraph 13: Nashville, TN is on the Cumberland River, not the Tennessee; cities on the Tennessee include Huntsville, AL and Chattanooga and Knoxville, TN. The two rivers are both tributaries of the Ohio, and are connected by Barkley Canal (1.5 mi.) just above Barkley L&D on the Cumberland and Kentucky L&D on the Tennessee.
