

Teaching aid is used in the ABC Class to describe Regulatory Marks and their use. The first of these was done in June before our second ABC Class. We had in the past used a rolled up piece of poster paper to show what they looked like. I understand that had helped in the past. I notice it was faded and was bent and really looked tired. So that is when the idea came to me to make a more stable aid that would be transported if need without risk of damage.

This was made with 4" diameter PVC pipe Orange vinyl electrical tape Ruler Scissors

After collecting our materials it probably took about 20 minutes. We have since made others. The one that was most difficult was the one for **restricted maneuvering**. It is hard to make a circle on circular pipe using a straight line. It definitely took more time 60 minutes.

Total cost \$12 per buoy.

When we had our first ABC Class in February 2015 we had 23students. Out of that class 8 students missed question number 32. Average test scores were 91.9%.

In June 2015 we had our second ABC Class. This class had 15 students with two dropping out after first Saturday. Out of this class 1 person-missed question 32. Average scores were 95.0%.
