Title of Proposed Project: FIRE EXTINGUISHING TRAINING

Total Amount of Grant Funding Requested from USPS Educational Fund: \$ 14,865.15

Description of Project (please limit to 300 words):

Fire extinguishing is one of the skills required to be demonstrated as part of the Inland Navigator certification. We have encountered quite a number of areas where live fires are not allowed for testing. In addition, the cost of acquiring and recharging extinguishers can be prohibitive if the local fire department does not do it for us. Fire is one of the greatest fear factors for most boaters; therefore, it behooves us to find a way to train boaters. Our new emphasis is hands-on training. We also seek to allow boaters to practice firefighting under various conditions.

We have discovered an ideal solution. An electronic device produced by BullEx uses a panel that displays simulated fires. The firefighter uses a real extinguisher that has a laser in the nozzle. By sweeping the "fire" properly it can be extinguished, but it is not easy as the amount of simulated dry chemical is limited. The device called a BullsEye™ laser trainer offers 3 classes of simulated fire at 4 difficulty levels.

It is our proposal to acquire one of these systems with travel case that can be circulated to districts and squadrons for training. We have a quote from BullEx in the amount of \$12,255.15 for a system to which we would add \$175 for wheels on the case. We will train operators using a USPS member who is a certified fireman. We seek expenses for travel to Raleigh for 4 people for a day to train at 4 x \$400 for airfare, 4 x \$90 for hotel, \$225 for auto rental, and \$250 misc ground transport and expenses for a total of \$2,435 and a total grant request of \$14,865.15. We will invite others to participate in the training at their own (or local squadron/district) expense.
