- To receive and act upon reports of officers and committees.
- II To elect a Board of Directors, national officers, the chairmen and members of the general and standing committees, the chairmen and assistant chairmen of the departmental committees, and general members of the Governing Board. (See *Report of the Committee on Nominations* which is incorporated into and made a part of this *Call*.)
- III To consider and act upon any other business that may properly come before this meeting.

DRESS CODE:

Sunday to Thursday - USPS casual or other appropriate attire.

Thursday evening - Blazer w/tie or appropriate after-six attire

Friday - Day: Uniform T: tropical Hawaiian style shirt (preferred), USPS blazer with tie, open-collar or USPS polo shirt or other appropriate attire

Saturday daytime: Uniform F. **Men**: Regulation long-sleeve white shirt/black four-in-hand tie/black uniform trousers, black belt (if worn), black socks, black shoes, or other appropriate attire. **Ladies**: Regulation long-sleeve white blouse with black cross-over tie, black skirt or slacks, black shoes, black purse (if carried) or other appropriate attire.

Saturday evening: Uniform A with bow tie or USPS blazer with tie for men; evening attire or party dresses for women.

Report of the Committee on Rules

With the concurrence of the USPS Board of Directors, the Committee on Rules recommends the following revisions to the *USPS Bylaws* to be effective as of the adjournment of the 2016 Governing Board.

CURRENT

Article 5, Section 5.2 Under Governing Board

The Governing Board shall consist of the chief commander; the vice commanders; the rear commanders; the district commanders; the district educational officers; members of the general committees; the squadron commanders; past chief commanders; past vice commanders who have served a minimum of two full elected terms as such; Governing Board members emeriti; squadron delegates as provided in Section 10.2 and *elected general members* at the rate of 600 active members of USPS in good standing as of the first day of **March**. The number of general members shall not be exceeded by the total number of Rear Commanders.

REVISED

Article 5, Section 5.2 Under Governing Board

The Governing Board shall consist of the chief commander; the vice commanders; the rear commanders; the district commanders; the district educational officers; members of the general committees; the squadron commanders; past chief commanders; past vice commanders who have served a minimum of two full elected terms as such; Governing Board members emeriti; squadron delegates as provided in Section 10.2 and *elected general members* at the rate of 600 active members of USPS in good standing as of the first day of **October**. The number of general members shall not be exceeded by the total number of Rear Commanders.

Rationale

With this revision the calculation relating to Governing Board members would need to be run only once in October and the Committee on Nominations would not be required to contact the District Commanders for their new recommendations.

CURRENT

<u>Article 8, Section 8.2</u> New members joining as a result of the efforts of a provisional squadron may be admitted as unattached members assigned to the provisional squadron until the provisional squadron is chartered.

REVISED

<u>Article 8, Section 8.2</u> New members and members transferring to a provisional squadron may be admitted as members assigned to the provisional squadron and to the sponsoring district it is assigned to, before and until the provisional squadron is officially chartered.

Rationale

In order to clarify that provisional squadrons are part of a sponsoring district to which they are assigned and the district officers have access to member information of the provisional squadron.

Add New

<u>Article 8, Section 8.4</u> Members of a provisional squadron that is for any reason dissolved or fails to meet the requirements to charter shall be transferred to the closest squadron of their choosing, their original squadron or to the Internet Membership squadron.

Rationale

To clarify what actions shall take place should a provisional squadron be dissolved.

CURRENT

Article 11, Section 11.2 No member shall be eligible for election to office at an Annual Meeting unless nominated (1) by the Committee on Nominations or (2) by a petition (a) signed by at least 10 active members from each of at least six squadrons, such squadrons being components of not fewer than three districts and (b) filed with the national secretary not less that 30 days prior to the Annual Meeting at which such election is to take place. Below each signature on such petition shall appear the hand-lettered or typed name, address, certificate number and squadron affiliation of the signer.

REVISED

Article 11, Section 11.2 No member shall be eligible for election to office by the Governing Board unless nominated (1) by the Committee on Nominations or (2) by a petition (a) signed by at least 10 active members from each of at least six squadrons, such squadrons being components of not fewer than three districts and (b) filed with the national secretary not less that 15 days prior to the governing board at which such election is to take place. Below each signature on such petition shall appear the hand-lettered or typed name, address, certificate number and squadron affiliation of the signer.

Rationale

USPS now only conducts Governing Board Meetings (albeit one is titled or referred to as the Annual Meeting of the Governing Board). To revise the time limit for filing petitions to give members time to receive the call and then file the petition.

CURRENT

Article 11, Section 11.3 No member shall be eligible for election to office by the Governing Board unless nominated (1) by the Committee on Nominations or (2) by petition signed by at least 25 members of the Governing Board and filed with the National Secretary at least 20 days prior to the meeting of the Governing Board at which such election is to take place.

REVISED

Article 11, Section 11.3 Delete in its entirety and mark Reversed

Rationale

With revision of Section 11.2 the requirements specified in 11.3 are now moot.
