Elizabeth stressed Johnson's philosophy on investments:

- Never risk everything on any one market forecast.

Decision made to leave investments as they stand and not to transfer any monies to

Johnson Investment Counsel at this stage, also no draw was currently necessary.

Review written report from R/C Shirley Heald – on open Marketing grants.

The trustees discussed the success of the ABC Manual grant, the final cost to the

Educational Fund was circa \$142,000. The 20 manuals were well received by the

squadrons, and that money was a benefit to the USPS cash flow.
