## Minutes November 7, 2023 Meeting Privateer Yacht Club, Hixson, TN

There was a call for volunteers for the veterans parade to be held Saturday Nov. 11 in Rossville, GA, in which we will again have our boat float. Line-up is around 12;30, with the parade starting at 2 pm. Sue Kuemmel requested permission to have 2 banners made for either side of the float. This request was approved by vote. Thanks to all who will be participating in this important event.


Marty Heck shared that John DiPrima is currently at Memorial Hospital in Chattanooga. He shared that he has a blood clot in his liver blocking venous return flow. We will be sending him a Get-Well card wishing him a speedy recovery.

Sue Kuemmel also brought up the following:

- a) We will be gathering on Dec. 5<sup>th</sup> and joining PYC at the clubhouse in Hixson from 5-7+pm. Please bring a dish to share....the clubs will be providing the meats. We will again be holding our interesting White Elephant gift exchange so please bring a fun or funny gift to exchange....think things from your attic or garage, thrift store, local shops, etc.
- b) Marty Lafferty, who coordinates filming some for the educational/safety videos for the ABC, contacted Sue to express interest in having the Chattanooga Squadron be involved in one of the videos. Sue chose 3 possible topics she was presented with: Fueling a boat; Launch Ramp Etiquite; or Cordless ECOS (engine cut-off switch should driver fall overboard). All agreed our Squadron should participate, and that Sue and Marty should decide on the topic. Please let Sue know if you have a preference for topics or are interested in participating. The filming will likely take place sometime during the week of May 13-17, tentatively.

- c) The Sea Scouts ship will meet the second week of November at Stuart Heights Baptist Church in Soddy Daisy, TN. They have been donated as small sailboat, so their adventure is about to begin!
- d) Treasurer Tom collected donations for our annual contribution to the Samaritan Center. The Center will not sponsor a "Gift Shop" this year. They are seeing more need in the areas of budgetary expenditures. They have been providing weekend "Pack Sacks" for school children, providing school supplies for teachers and students, and helping the homeless through the McClellan Shelter and renters through their rent program. In addition to supporting an increasing monthly Food Box program, the area has had an influx of immigrants who need financial counselling and monetary support. All this at a significantly increased cost due to inflation has significantly impacted their budget. So, this year we are asking member NOT to bring \$20 gifts, but to consider bringing a CHECK for \$20 (or more), made out to the Squadron, which we can then donate to the Center.


