

Boating Beyond the Basics

Boat Handling course is being offered this spring here in Beaufort. This course is a logical progression for the ABC class. Every club member is encouraged to take this course.

Even if you do not have a boat, it is important that you know more than just what is covered in ABC when talking with the public.

The course consists of a package of six two-hour seminars, each expanding on a key area of boating. We will also have an on the water component to this class.

Mark your calendars for April 27, May 4, and May 11.

We will have 3 seminars a day on first two Saturdays and on the 11th, we will have a review, the exam, and a field trip to an on the water experience.

As a **Members Benefit**, members can take the full course for free with the purchase of the book for \$55. Family members may share a book at no additional cost. The seminars are also free to members, but each registered participant must purchase the seminar book for of \$25 each. (That will cost you \$150 if you sign up for all six seminars, so the course is a bargain.)

Costs for nonmembers are posted online.

Students who complete the Boat Handling course and pass the exam will receive credit for the Boat Handling course and earn the Seaman grade.
