As we put another month of winter in the books and look forward to March and the Vernal Equinox, I am pleased to report multiple new developments in our Squadron, the District and at the National levels.

First at the squadron level. I am pleased to inform you that Harve Norris and Mary Krieger have agreed to Join our Membership Committee chair Nicki Smethells and bring their great ideas and talents to this very important committee. They will resurrect the report of the previously hired consultant and use it begin to implement the recommendations. They will also review the work of our internal membership task force and prioritize the recommendations that were incorporated in the task force report.

During our Executive Committee meeting last Thursday we had a good discussion about increasing awareness in the local market about America's Boating Club, and what our squadron does locally. Some of the ideas discussed included radio advertising, Public Service Announcements, interviews with local radio stations and getting our name in the Record Eagle summer circular. Others were partnering with the Children's Museum to do a boater safety course and work with local marinas and Traverse City on a life jacket loaner program.

All of these are excellent ideas, but now we must move ideas to actions. The Bridge is looking for multiple members who would like to volunteer to lead and work together towards accomplishing the above to promote greater awareness in our local market. Most importantly, this includes recommendations on our website and leveraging social media. Finally, we are exploring getting a booth at the Traverse City Boat Show which will be held March 17-19.

At the District level, the Spring Conference will be held April 28-29 in Bay City. More details to follow. Also, Alana Harvey will soon vacate the D–9 commander position which she has held for an extended period. We thank her and wish her the best.

At the National level, the National Meeting will be held February 25th in Orlando, FL where changes to the by-laws will be voted upon. Our squadron has two votes. Janet Ward and I will be voting remotely on the changes. For more information about those changes, please refer to the National website for details. If you have comments about the proposed changes, please send them to me prior to the 25th.

Our March meeting will be held March 2nd at Sleders. The President of Wallstrom Marine will be our presenter and will discuss the growth in Wallstrom's business including the recent acquisition of Grand Bay Marine. We look forward to seeing you then.
