

# P/C Bernard Suskind, AP to be named Honorary Citizen of his home town in Germany

Most of us live relatively unexciting lives and it is hard to relate to the experiences *others* have had. Bernard Suskind is one of those *other* people.

To listen to his life story one can only imagine what he went through as those who know him, only see an optimistic and cheerful person.

Bernie was born in Furstenau, a small town in Germany. In 1938, at the age of 17, he was arrested by the Nazis. Ironically, the man who apprehended him and took him to the concentration camp was formerly his father's best friend. Fortunately, after about two and a half months, an emaciated Bernie was rescued by the Swedish government and after more harrowing experiences, he got out of Nazi Germany and went to Sweden.

He came to America; served in the US Army; returned to Europe and was there when victory was achieved. He even had the satisfaction of helping to prosecute the Nazi offenders in his hometown. Submitted by P/L/C Roy Katoff,JN

Now here we are in the year 2000. Bernie has had a good life .He is a successful businessman. He has raised a fine family and *even* became Commander of South Shore Power Squadron.

In the intervening years, he repeatedly returned to his roots in Germany to tell his story in schools, to civic groups and anywhere he was asked to speak. He wanted to be certain that the horrible events of the past were properly documented.

There are many people in his town who are anxious that he do this and of course there are others who do not want the story to be told. However, after much debate the townspeople have elected to make Bernie an Honorary Citizen of Furstenau and on the 28<sup>th</sup> of February, Bernie and Charlotte took sail once again for Germany and to a most fitting honor.
