## **Seamanship**

Seamanship will start on Wednesday, 23 January 2013 at the former Richardson School, 95 Pine Street, Attleboro, MA. Class will be held from 1900-2100. The course will run for 10 weeks with the exam scheduled for 3 April 2013. This course is the first step in building a foundation for confidence and competence for the safe operation on the water. It extends the knowledge and skills of boat handling and maneuvering a vessel, sail or power. The course provides a better understanding of how boats handle under various conditions, including close quarters and open water operations.

### **Piloting**

Piloting will start on Tuesday, 15 January 2013 at the former Richardson School. Class will be held from 1900-2100. The course will run for 11 weeks with the exam scheduled for 2 April 2013. This course is the first and most basic navigation course, covering chart reading, course plotting, and basic coastal or inland navigation, including basic GPS usage. This course goes into more detail than the charting information covered in the public courses.
