

January 18 meeting venue to be announced. February and March will be Zoom meetings so that we can include the snow birders and avoid going out in the nasty winter weather.





No birthdays to report for November. I hope to see you at this month's membership meeting at Paper Moon Vineyards in Vermilion.



A short report from your secretary. We are still doing rehab from the car accident. Plan to attend the meeting at Paper Moon Vineyards.


