

January meeting venue to be announced. February and March may be Zoom but we'll decide as the time nears.




The Fall Conference for District 7 will take place on Saturday, November 4. It will be held at the Reinecker's Party Center in Macedonia.


Lunch is from 1 to 2, with a guest speaker, followed by the business meeting.


Happy birthday to everyone.


SEO Dave Bialorucki is setting up an A.B.C. class at Power Boats in October, and a Seamanship class at Beaver Park in November.


